The <u>ZRA Training Certificate Program for Zoological Registrars</u> will be held at the 2017 Annual Conference in Columbus, Ohio on Friday, 29 September. Cost for this workshop is included with a full-conference registration; if attending only the training class, the cost is \$45 for non-members and daily registrants. The focus of the class is "The Basics": best practices and key principles for the zoological registrar role and for creating, managing and maintaining high quality animal records.
