

Critically Endangered

Fewer than 7,000 Sumatran orangutans remain in the wild.

In the last decade, close to 80% of deforestation in the Sumatra peatlands was driven by the expansion of oil palm plantations.

As demand for palm oil continues to grow, habitat for extraordinary wildlife such as orangutans will continue to disappear *unless...*manufacturers begin to use more *sustainable* palm oil in their products.

What is Palm Oil?

Palm oil can be found in almost 50% of the packaged foods we eat and in many of the cosmetics, lotions, cleaning and laundry products we use.

Most palm oil is currently grown in a *non*-sustainable manner, but that is beginning to change.

The Roundtable on Sustainable Palm Oil was formed to promote growing practices that are safe for the environment and has developed a certification process for palm oil producers.



Choose Sustainable Palm Oil

Sustainable palm oil is grown on land that has already been cleared rather than destroying additional rainforest.

Choosing products made by companies that have committed to using certified sustainable palm oil is critical to protecting orangutans.

Check your labels when you shop to see who manufactures the brands you buy. This card will help you learn which brands are made by orangutan-friendly companies.



Write to your favorite manufacturers and tell them you value their commitment to using sustainable palm oil. Let them know you hope they will follow through sooner rather than later; without your feedback, they won't know you care.
